On the personal front, I have managed a few races myself in the T&F League I made it to the Milton Keynes match and walked for the team and non scored in the 3000m, that was my first competition in almost 15 months. I also walked in the final as can be seen in the photo above just behind Sue Rey. Why was I in the women's race? Well that's a long story.

I was also chief timekeeper at the T&F finals and am very grateful to my small team of timekeepers. All our Track & Field events rely on the goodwill of many officials be they starters, marksman, track judges, field judges, timekeepers or scorers. Behind the scenes there are often more people ensuring refreshments are available. I offer a big thank you to them all on your behalf.

All clubs and leagues are desperately short of officials nowadays. It is easy to help out and there are plenty of entry level courses across the East of England in the coming months, look on the England Athletics website for details.

EVAC Annual General Meeting Sunday 11 September 2011, Bedford

The AGM took place immediately after the conclusion of the T&F League finals. The officers of the club were re-elected unopposed. Our Chair, Jan Lawson, gave the report you can find printed below.

Our Treasurer, Brenda Russell, presented the club accounts for the year to 31 March 2011. Although the accounts gave the clubs position as at the 31 March 2011, Brenda has been chasing up the club assets and liabilities from past periods and this work is not quite complete. We will give a full picture of the finances in the next issue of the magazine.

Graeme Packman, our T&F League Secretary, initiated a discussion about the T&F League in 2012. This is likely to be affected by the London Olympics, There will be more on this point in the next issues of the magazines hopefully things will be clearer soon.

Jan Lawson's speech

Thank you all for coming today and making it such a good competitive end to the season. The League has had a good year with another 2 teams joining to give 15 men's and 13 ladies' teams in total & it is especially pleasing to see one of these teams (Kettering Ladies) here at the final. We hope all of these teams will be in the League again next year and that we will find even more teams to take part.

There have, however, been a few downsides this year:-

- the imbalance in the number of teams in each division- we are already looking at reconfiguring the Fenland and Central divisions for next year so that we have 6 teams in each -assuming everyone rejoins
- the Essex division is of particular concern with only 3 men's and 2 ladies teams.
- Given this, it is especially pleasing to see ALL of the Essex teams here at the Final.

I do need to stress that Graeme, other members of the Committee and the team managers of the existing Essex division teams have been making considerable efforts to try to recruit more teams into this Essex division. We seem to suffer from competition from the Southern Counties Vets League with clubs generally not keen to be in both Leagues although many of the athletes do compete in both.

Another major downside is the increasing difficulties we are facing in getting enough officials to cover these matches. This problem affects every League in the country so we are not alone. We don't in principle wish to go the route of the junior and young athlete leagues of penalising clubs for not bringing officials but we are sailing close to the wind at times.

I would on behalf of myself and the whole committee like to thank not only all the officials who have worked so hard today but those who have given so much support throughout the season often in uncomfortable conditions. I would also like to thank the Bedford club for hosting us here today. Many thanks to Trevor Buck, Bob Thomson, Bernard Wells and Courtney Gunn and their support team for their efforts behind the scenes. Also, of course, huge thanks to the track staff.

Besides the Track & Field League we have also had successful Indoor and Outdoor Championships. Although he is not here today I would particularly like to thank John Painter of City of Norwich AC for hosting the outdoor champs again at Kings Lynn. John is planning to offer to host the outdoor champs again next year and is looking at options of holding them at a more central venue such as Cambridge. We are giving John our full support on this and hope to be able to announce more info during the winter.

I would also like to pay tribute to our EVAC teams that took part in the Vets Inter Area match at Solihull back at the beginning of August. Our men's team did it's best for several years with an emphatic 3rd place and our ladies team, although the official results show us finishing runners up, are claiming a moral victory as one of our athletes was mistakenly recorded as competing for another area. Well done to both of them and to Graeme and Gaye for all their hard work in organizing the teams.

We are already planning next year and we will go onto discuss this in more detail in the next few minutes. However, I must just stress the considerable uncertainty that surrounds next season something to do with another athletics event that appears to be taking place in East London! I know that many of you will be involved as officials and volunteers (and if you were really lucky as spectators) for the able bodied and the Paralympics. I am also aware that Graeme has already been making considerable efforts with UKA to get clarity as to what will be happening next year- with no great response. It is inevitable that the Olympics will severely impact on our season next year. We will try to minimise the impact but this once in a lifetime event may need us to compromise severely on what we normally do. Can I just ask for your patience and understanding.

I would like to give my personal thanks to the EVAC Committee that have made this season happen- there is a lot of work goes in behind the scenes. Also to all the team managers without whom none of this would happen either. I just hope their teams appreciate what their team managers need to do. I know mine do- of course!

Finally could I wish good luck to all those athletes that are heading off to Italy in the next few days. I know some have gone already but others have waited specially to be here today. Thank you once again and over to the rest of the meeting.

Les Percival - a potted life in sport and TV

Les Percival contacted me after the last magazine as I had incorrectly labelled a photo of him. I invited Les to put things right.

Athletics started early for me, as a well developed boy quite big for his age. I was the local primary school champion, running I believe 80 yards then. No great surprise there it was only a tin-pot primary with not a lot of competition. The only thing of note was that the fastest girl was a girl called Marilyn Neufville who went on to run for Jamaica which caused quite a storm because everyone thought she would run for Great Britain.

When I reached secondary school rugby was the order of the day, which was like bread & water to me. I captained the school & soon

went on to play for the old boys team. Finding myself at the age of 14 playing for the school on Saturday mornings, the old boys club on Saturday afternoon & a pub team on Sundays. My rugby career was crowned when I joined Blackheath Rugby Club which at the time was one of the premier clubs in the country, I found myself playing at Cardiff Arms park & Murrayfield to name just two. The most wonderful thing about this was I now found myself playing against my boyhood heroes people like Andy Ripley, Bob Hiller & David Duckham all were playing for the opposition. These were great times but they came to an abrupt end when I was laying in a hospital bed & my pregnant wife came in to see me & words like responsibility came into my head & I thought enough is enough get out while you can.

I then dabbled with goal keeping at football for a while & to my surprise people would jump out of the way when I dived on the ball. It was at this point I won my only road race it was the Staplehurst 5 miles & my prize was a raffle ticket with number one on it. Though I was 16 stone I quite liked this running game & soon got into the running boom running in the end 15 marathons including 5 Londons. Not that I was any good, my best half marathon time was 1hr 18 mins coming 76th not bad out of over a thousand, but I knew in my heart I was the wrong size & build.

My big break came my 8 year old daughter suddenly wanted to join an Athletics Club & of course dad had to go along as well. I soon found on a track I could compete with the best of them it didn't really matter when my daughter left, I was hooked. The club we joined was called Paddock Wood & my daughter still holds the 80m under 10 record. With Paddock Wood I entered the Kent veterans champs & won, in fact for the last 7 years I've managed to win one title or other.

At the age of 50 I decided to move away to Lincolnshire & retire giving me more time to indulge & started entering the national competitions, I never received a gold medal but was more than happy with a couple of silvers.

With more time on my hands I decided to enter the BBC Total Wipeout Series & to my surprise I got an audition & was selected to go out to Argentina & compete. Well when I got there the average age was twentyish with me being the grandfather image, which was quite appropriate as my first grandson was born on the week before. Well the old boy did well being the oldest guy in the country to get into the wipeout zone, in the final my two competitors were a semi pro wrestler 32 years younger than me & a semi pro footballer 23 years younger than me so it wasn't really a fair fight. As I got through to the last 3, I was asked to go back for the champion of champions show; another 16 hrs on a plane. The icing on the cake came last December when the show went global for a week with Great Britain taking on the rest of the world. I was asked to be the Great Britain captain, things just couldn't get any better than this, what a honour.

On a high with this I decided to enter the European indoor champs in Gent but my training had suffered so I put all my eggs in one basket & just entered the 200m. I was in the first heat of the 200m with the first 2 & 2 fastest losers going through I came third. I walked off thinking what a waste of time & money. When I got into the stand a friend told me I had run well & would go through, my time of 26.3 was the 6th fastest in the heats. In the semi's it was the first 3 through & I came third. In the final there were four Brits Steve Peters, Wally Franklin, Ian Broadhurst & me. The final didn't go as planned I was in the inside lane & at 16 stone I'm not designed to go round sharp corners, I finished last. However, I confidently put my name down for the relay. The next day was the 60m & David Elderfield & Ivars Licietis came out & both ran really well.

That evening we had a chat about the relay team, we all wanted the best team to run but Steve had to drop out with a slight strain. Although I had run in the final & was the 4th fastest of the Brits in the 200m, I knew Ivars was faster than me so I did the right thing & let him run.

On the final day of the champs the relay team was to be David, Wally, Ian & Ivars; a good team that should wipe the floor with the rest of the competition. Two hours before the race David came up to me & asked me to take his place in the relay as he had a slight pulled muscle. I had to compose myself, I was now going to run in the Great Britain relay team as the anchor leg runner replacing David. The championship final was run as a time trial with 2 heats & the fastest team winning. Well, all went well & I took the baton with a lead of 60m or so & ran 26.9. We then had to wait for the second heat with the Germans in, and they were nowhere to be seen. Our time was 1 min 42.59 secs less than 2 seconds off the European record.

Well that was going to be my swan song, but no I've one more challenge I'm going to swim the channel next.
