Just after George's letter he was off to Nijmegen to compete in an International, but was worried about his prospects because of a slightly twisted knee. However with strapping and PARACETAMOL he was hoping to compete.

Fred Copping, Ipswich, wrote sending his entry for the cross country and hoping to run. His main reason for writing was to point out that he had competed in the Track and Field Championships at Corby and finished 2nd in his age group in the 100 metres and long jump, also finishing first in his age group in the 5000 metres. Although he stayed for the presentation he was surprised that he did not receive a medal for being 1st.

This was an oversight on our part and Fred should now have his medal for 1st O/60 in the 5000metres. Editor

"With reference to the E.V.A.C. T/F Championships, please note that it should have been Winston Thomas and not Bill Thomas (Winner of M45, 100, 200, and Long Jump) as reported in the introduction to the results.

Whilst I felt we had a good day at the Championships, I would like to make a couple of points that were voiced in the background, and being a field official myself, I feel this one particularly may need close attention. The problem being that we do not look after the officials well enough, a drink and maybe a light snack and the field referee being around to see everything is going right. Secondly, we seemed to have run out of medals at the last two championships, and the athletes have to wait a very long time before they are received. So could we not have some extra medals, so that if the entries are greater than anticipated we have enough to cover all the presentations."

Colin Shafto, Shipton, Yorks. Writes:

"Just a note to point out a slight error in the E.V.A.C. Championships results as printed in the November newsletter. I finished 1st. in the M50-54 400m H in 63.5 and Gordon Daborn was the winner of the 55-59 400H.

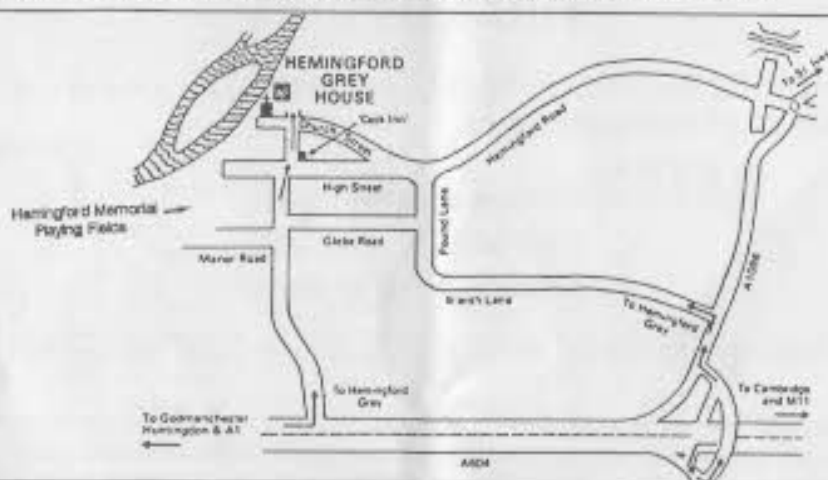
